



About the show: “Have I Got A Girl For You” (original title: Skin Deep)



Type of comedy: Modern Comedy About Romance

Plot: A large lovable lonely-heart named Maureen gives romance one last shot when her pushy sister sets her up on a blind date with sweet, awkward Joe. She relies on sharp wit and wisecracks to cover her feelings while he is a simple guy who can't contain his eagerness. They are perfect for each other, even if they won't admit it.
