



## About the show: “Let’s Murder Marsha”



**Type of comedy:** Comedy/Mystery

**Plot:** A husband and wife have been extremely lucky in business and love but lately he’s working 24/7 at his job, and his wife Marsha sits at home in their posh New York apartment reading murder mystery novels and daydreaming. Marsha wishes her husband would notice her again; he seems dissatisfied and complains about her crazy clothes and her constant reading of murder mystery books.
