



## About the show: "Who Goes Bare?"



**Type of comedy:** Farce

**Plot:** Two middle aged brothers own a rundown vacation spa. One brother has a knack for making money, the other has a knack for spending it. The black sheep brother operates the resort – poorly – and is in money trouble with the mob. The clever brother devises a scheme to save the spa by bringing in a beautiful young health-obsessed heiress as an investor. Both brothers are relieved: if they can convince "Miss Moneybags" to become a partner, they will be safe from the mob and financial ruin.

**Situations:** The young beautiful heiress has gotten the idea that the spa is actually a nudist camp, and is delighted. The brothers, their friends and their staff spend the entire time convincing "Miss Moneybags" that the place will bare it all, while at the same time convincing her conservative husband that the resort offers nothing but cucumber facials and exercise classes. While you're supposed to think the actors are baring it all, you will see nothing beyond creatively displayed legs and arms, exposed for humorous effect. There are many innuendoes, where one character is innocent of all guilt, and the humor comes from another character assuming that they are guilty.

**Language:** There are scattered hells, damns and maybe a "silly ass" here and there.

**We think this play is suitable for:** Adults who love to laugh at mainstream comedy, and have just a little tolerance of naughtiness. It's for those who realize innuendo is harmless: half fact, half misunderstanding, and all in good fun.

**We think you should avoid this play if:** Any of the above bothers you at all.
